Even in my darkest times, many over the two years has gave up on me, but store house for Jesus has been a huge part of my growing and never has. In many lives the story's are not much different, hard working God fearing folks facing stormy times and God uses those who listen to make this world a little more like His, in this journey we are not guaranteed a smooth life but if we are smart and slow down these times we can get closer to God and learn more about each other.

Financial donations were received from 20 states - 63 cities and towns.

We are a completely volunteer ministry - no one has ever received a salary. In 2015 our volunteers served over 46,412 hours. We were blessed with 333+ volunteers.

Our auditors report 98% of all incoming money goes directly to client/patient services – 97 to 98% is consistent, year after year.

TWO COATS DOCUMENT 2016 VOLUNTEER NEEDS

Need something fulfilling in your life...maybe to feel blessed at the end of the day? I believe anyone who volunteers at A Storehouse for Jesus would tell you that's how they feel after a day serving others in need and the fellowship they have working with other volunteers.

There are so many different kinds of things volunteers may do from medical to distribution to picking up food. Below is a list of our most needed volunteers at this time, keeping in mind that volunteers are always needed in every area.

DRIVERS: Pick up food from area stores **9:00-11:00 AM Sunday through Saturday.**

LAWN MAINTENANCE: Mowing and weed eating.

CHECKOUT: Volunteers that record number of food, clothing and household items clients receive. Monday, Wednesday and Thursday mornings 8:30-12:30. Also Tuesday's 12:30-4:30 depending.

INTERVIEWERS: Volunteers have one-on-one contact with client's, praying & sharing the Gospel of Christ; if the client desires, and filling out paperwork for food pantry and checkout. Monday, Wednesday and Thursday mornings 8:30-noon; and Tuesday's 12:30-4:30.

RECEPTIONIST: Monday through Thursday – 8:30-noon, 12:00 to 2:00 & 2:00-5:00.

CLOTHING SORTERS AND HANGERS: Monday through Thursday morning or afternoon.

PHARMACIST: Monday, Tuesday, Wednesday mornings and Thursday evenings.

DOCTORS, PHYSICIAN ASSISTANTS, PHARMACISTS, OPTOMETRISTS, NURSES, LAB TECHNICIANS, DENTISTS, MEDICAL ASSISTANT PROGRAM INTERVIEWERS, PHARMACY TECHS.

A Message from the Medical Ministries Director

The number of clients that A Storehouse for Jesus Medical Ministry is serving each week has increased at an alarming rate over the past year. The statistics indicate that approximately 1.9 million North Carolina residents are currently receiving Medicaid Services. The clients that we provide medical services to, do not qualify for Medicaid Services. This fact is placing an ever increasing burden on our free Medical Services Ministry as the clients that we serve have no access to health insurance or any type of medical assistance.

We currently offer the following medical services to our clients.

1. *Monday – Woman’s Clinic held once a month.*
2. *Tuesday morning - Chronic Care Clinic*
3. *Tuesday morning - Psychiatric Clinic*
4. *Thursday evenings - Medical Clinic*
5. *Chiropractic Clinic – twice per month*
6. *Eye Clinic – once per month*
7. *Dental – once per month*

Each of these clinics requires 4 nurses, 2 receptionists, 2 pharmacists, 3+ RNs, CNAs and 2-3 Medical providers (Physicians, Physician Assistants and/or nurse practitioners).

To keep the clinics running smoothly we have a medical record librarian and two nurses who are referral specialists. They also do follow-up referrals and statics. Each clinic also requires several translators.

Twice per week, a diabetic and nutritonal educator comes from the Department of Health to provide educational services to our clients that are dealing with Diabetes.

Our Medical ministry stays extremely busy and we never have enough volunteer medical staff to efficiently serve the needs of our patients.

The Storehouse Medical Ministry is a very comprehensive medical practice that serves a tremendous amount of medical needs for our community. We first assess a patient’s medical situation and then see that patient all the way through their complex medical environment. Our goal is to effectively treat them making sure that they have a good outcome. Many of our patients have multiple critical health problems when they first come to see us which requires a good amount of time to assess and evaluate.

We are so very grateful to all of our volunteer medical staff that work very hard to treat the many clients that visit our medical clinic. We are especially grateful for our Head Nurse, Sister Martha Hoyle, who oversees and manages the entire operation of our medical services.

We want to express our appreciation to all of our volunteers.
